LOW ROPES

Our Challenge Course program is active rather than passive. We emphasize hands-on conditions because people learn best by doing and then reflecting on their experience. We use problem solving games, initiatives, and a series of elements and games that foster cooperation, trust, positive risk taking, leadership, active listening, problem solving, communication, trust and self confidence.

Team building games and low ropes activities are appropriate and available for all ages.

HIGH ROPES COURSE

Our High Ropes Course involves a series of elements that challenge participants to climb to a height of 35ft. While many events will provide a challenge to the individual, there is still a valuable and significant group focus. This program features the "Leap of Faith", a hair raising jump from the top of the course!

Minimum group size of 8 participants with an ideal group being 10-25. Groups of up to 80 can be accommodated by dividing the group between low ropes, high ropes and games.

CLIMBING TOWER

Our 35' three sided climbing tower can be used to teach many lifetime skills such as goal setting, perseverance, teamwork and encouraging others. Rockclimbing is a great activity for any age and available to our youngest guests.
